Irish Links golf courses:



Doonbeg Golf Club - is regularly ranked as one of the top 100 courses in the World to play. The course was built by Greg Norman, and was designed to be totally in tune with nature. It is the priceless jewel between Lahinch and Ballybunion and one that simply must be played.



Tralee Golf Club-Palmer has designed a course that will stimulate the senses every bit a much as the breathtaking scenery. According to folklore, Palmer created the first nine and Mother Nature did the rest.



Lahinch Golf Club - Frequently referred to as the St. Andrews of Ireland, The Old Course is a classic seaside Links course consistently ranked in the World's Top 50. The course was modernized in 2003 by Martin Hawtree and is an enchanting place to play golf.



Waterville Golf Links - A magical Links course where it's remote location has precluded it from hosting any major competitions, but many famous golfers have found their way here and have not been disappointed.



Ballybunion, Old Course -Ballybunion is a supreme test of golf; if there is an onshore breeze blowing, you are best to forget scoring well and simply enjoy this exhilarating golf course. Bill Clinton played here in 1998, apparently taking more "mulligan's" than you can shake a golf club at!



The Old Head - a remarkably dramatic piece of land, protruding over two miles into the Atlantic Ocean. You certainly will not forget your helicopter landing here with breathtaking views of the headland and fairways.
